

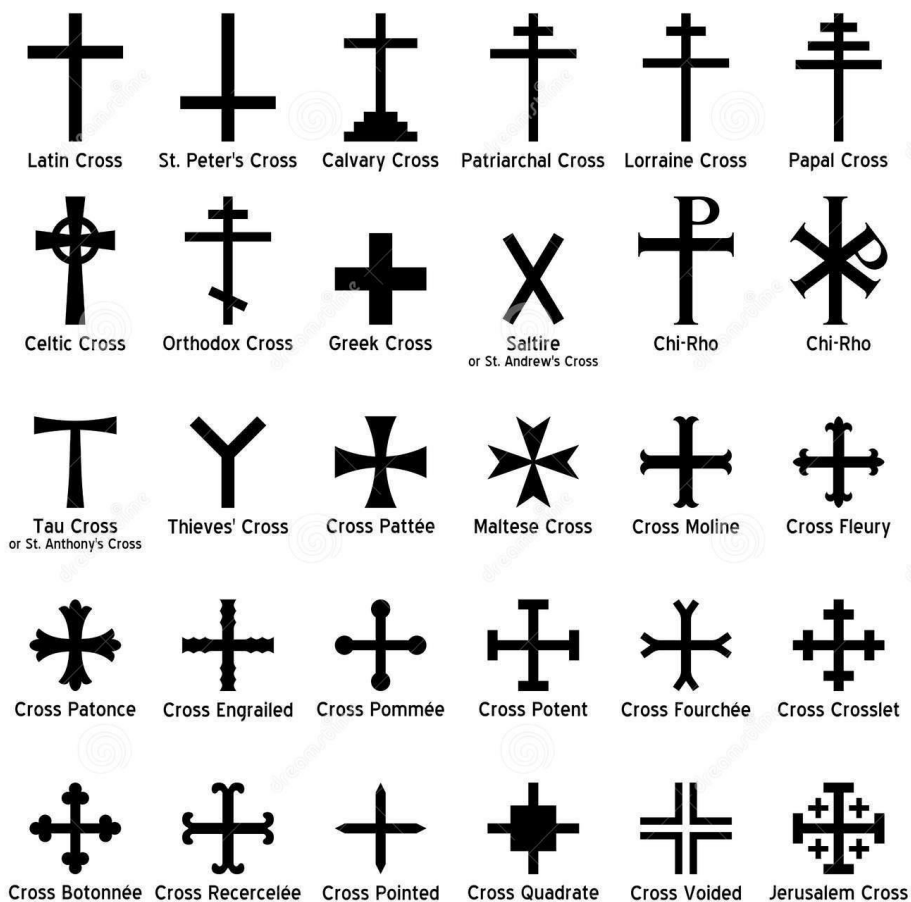

- We live in an age dominated by signs and symbols. The sign of one letter “M” for McDonalds is known throughout the world. Signs and symbols for supermarkets are known by all ages in society.



- The universal symbol of Christianity is the cross. But the designs of the cross are many and varied. {A sheet showing varied cross designs was distributed to the congregation. People were asked for their favourites/most meaningful designs}.



- The cross points in all four directions – North, South, East and West. It points up and down and left and right.
- This reminds us of John 3: 16 – “God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him may not perish but have eternal life”.
- A universal sign for a worldwide love, available and open for all.
